Re: Request for Septic Tank Approval and Listing Update – Roth Septic Tank Re-Branding

Dear Mr. Stowe:

The Water Quality Control Division has received information in a July 2, 2008 letter that indicates that Roth Global Plastics purchased the assets of FRALO Plastech Manufacturing. The Water Quality Control Division has reviewed Roth Global Plastics' request to update product approvals provided for the FRALO Septech HDPE septic tanks to reflect their "re-branding" as Roth MultiTank products. As indicated in the July 2nd letter, the only change to the FRALO tanks is that the exterior color is black instead of blue and the inner layer will be composed of NSF61-listed HMW-HDPE. The following current (FRALO) listings and the updated (Roth) listings were provided.

The Division will update its records to reflect that the Roth MultiTank products are approved for use in Colorado. Please be advised that approval by the Water Quality Control Division as meeting design standards does not constitute approval for use in all 64-counties of the State of Colorado. Local health regulations may be more stringent than the requirements of the state Guidelines which were utilized in the review of these products.
