Re: Up-dated Appendix D: Approved Non-Concrete Septic Tanks

The Technical Standards for Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems stipulates that this Department must approve non-concrete septic tanks. This memorandum is being sent to all approved non-concrete septic tank manufacturers that submitted updated specifications, product information and installation instructions in accordance with provisions included in the January 1, 2007 Revisions of the Technical Standards. Attached please find an updated list of approved non-concrete septic tanks (Appendix D) dated June 5, 2008.

This Department will distribute the updated list via a Circular Letter to all local health departments in Connecticut, and to our Code Advisory Committee, which includes representation from the sewage system installer and designer associations. The Circular Letter will also be distributed to the tank manufacturers on the approved list, and it will be posted on the Department's website. As with all product approvals, this Department's approval should not be considered an endorsement of the product.

The Technical Standards stipulates that non-concrete septic tanks must be installed in strict adherence with the manufacturer's installation instructions, and proper bedding, backfill and compaction must be confirmed with each tank installation. All non-concrete septic tanks distributed in Connecticut must include installation instructions, and each approved tank manufacturer is responsible for ensuring that this Department is provided up to date installation instructions, tank specifications, and support documentation. Product modifications require approval from this Department.
