Dear Mr. Jones:

The Water Quality Control Division has reviewed the revised drawings for the Fraro Plastech Septic Tanks as provided on October 25, 2004. On the basis of this review, the Division is able, at this time, to state that these designs for the ST750 gallon, ST1060 gallon, ST1250 gallon, and ST1500 gallon tanks are consistent with the requirements of the State Board of Health *Guidelines On Individual Sewage Disposal Systems* with the following conditions. All tanks furnished to the State of Colorado will have 4" inlet and outlet tees as integral part of the tank and the liquid transfer from the first compartment to the second or successive compartments shall be made at a liquid depth of a least 14" below the outlet invert, but not in the sludge.

Please be advised that approval by the Water Quality Control Division as meeting design standards does not assure acceptability within all 64-counties of the State of Colorado. Local health authorities are empowered to promulgate, adopt, and enforce local regulations that are more stringent than the Guidelines, which were utilized in the review of this product.
