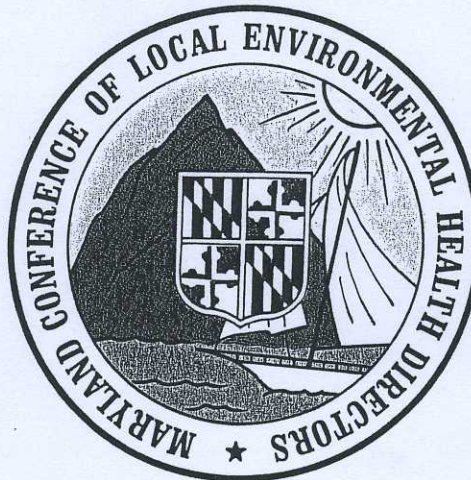

Dear Mr. Jones:

I am writing in reply to your request of December 9, 2003 asking for review and approval of the use of Fralo polyethylene septic tanks with riser and lid in the State of Maryland. Fralo models ST-750 (750 gallon tank), ST-1060 (1060 gallon tank), ST-1250 (1250 gallon tank), and ST-1500 (1500 gallon tank) and the septic tank access riser system were reviewed. The aforementioned products were reviewed by the Maryland Conference of Local Environmental Health Directors and Maryland Department of the Environment Groundwater Permits Programs Product Review Committee.

The committee reviewed the information submitted and found no objection to the use of the submitted tanks and riser system for new or replacement sewage disposal systems when installed according to Fralo instructions. The members of the Maryland Conference of Local Environmental Health Directors have been supplied with the available information on the reviewed polyethylene septic tank as well as the results of the Committee's review.

Please be advised that the authority for final product approval and use is delegated to the individual counties and they may have more stringent requirements than state regulations. Favorable review by the Committee does not eliminate the need for individual county approval.
