The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) has received your notification for the name change and acquisition /merger of Fralo Plastech to Roth Global Plastics, Inc. The original approval for Fralo Plastech was granted on October, 2003 and updated again in June, 2004.

The company name change/merger of products will not alter nor modify the specifications or requirements established in the original approval for the product in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3701-29 [Sewage Treatment System (STS) Rules].

Roth Global Plastics, Inc. is approved to continue producing septic tanks and must follow all previously approved guidelines stated in the original approval letter.

It is understood that the tanks will now have a different color going from the Fralo Blue to the Roth Black and renaming the tanks as Roth Multitank. The Septech brand produced by Fralo and also acquired through this merger will remain identical to the original approvals.

Please remember all approvals are subject to ODH review for compliance with the conditions of approval and applicable law and rules. A review may be conducted when there is evidence of noncompliance with approval conditions or for other reasons deemed necessary to assure compliance. Upon review, if there is a determination of noncompliance, a company may be removed from the approved list in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code.

APPROVAL OF THE NAME CHANGE OF FRALO PLASTECH TO ROTH GLOBAL PLASTICS INC




The Septech brand produced by Fralo and also acquired through this merger will remain identical to the original approvals.
